

Creating photo books and albums



Introduction

Creating a photobook or album is a great way to keep memories alive such as a wedding or a vacation, to show your portfolio, or simply for the fun of it.

Objective

To encourage you to make your own photobook using an online service via your computer. For a professional looking result, you'll need a few tricks up your sleeve – and that's what this workshop gives you.

Format

The workshop starts with some insights into organising your images. Then a diversion into understanding what goes where to create a story or a flow. Composition is as important for an album as it is for a single image so we have a look at 'thinking in spreads' (don't panic, the terminology is explained).

All helping you to design and create a photobook, album, calendar, or whatever, which is engaging for the viewer.

A demonstration shows the practicalities of uploading your images, then being creative placing images on the book's pages.

A handout is included. so you can do the job at home.
